Prior to coming to Saskatchewan, Maura was Vice-President, Planning and Performance for Capital Health, in Halifax, Nova Scotia. Maura has over 30 years experience in health care as a clinical dietitian, educator and senior executive.

Maura has Bachelor degrees in science and education and a Masters degree in health services administration. She is a Fellow of the Canadian College of Health Service Executives and a surveyor for the Canadian Council of Health Services Accreditation. Maura is a member of the boards of the Canadian Health Services Research Foundation and Canadian Patient Safety Institute. She holds a part time faculty appointment in the Department of Community Health and Epidemiology at the University of Saskatchewan. In 2007, Maura was selected by Saskatchewan Business Magazine as one of the Top 10 Women of Influence in Saskatchewan.
