

**Peter MacKinnon**  
**President and Vice-Chancellor**  
**University of Saskatchewan**

Peter MacKinnon became President of the U of S in July, 1999 following nine years as Dean of Law and one year as Acting Vice-President (Academic). He is a member of The Law Society of Saskatchewan, and served as a Bencher for ten years. He was appointed Queen's Counsel in 1990. His record includes the publication of many law review articles, reports and three books co-edited with colleagues in political science, as well as occasional appearances in courts at all levels.

President MacKinnon's previous appointments include presidencies of both the Canadian Association of Law Teachers and the Canadian Council of Law Deans and Chair of the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada.

He is a member of the Board of Directors of the Meewasin Valley Authority, the Saskatoon Regional Economic Development Authority, the Saskatoon Airport Authority, the Fathers of Confederation Buildings Trust, the Canadian Council on Learning and the Canadian Judicial Council Chairperson's Advisory Group.

In February, 2005 he received the Award for Distinguished Service from the Canadian Bar Association (Saskatchewan Branch).
