William L. Albritton was born in Andalusia, Alabama, obtained a PhD in Biochemistry from the University of Tennessee in 1968, and a MD from the Medical College of Alabama in 1970. After a Pediatric residency at Stanford University Medical center in Palo Alto, CA and two years in the US Public Health Service at CDC in Atlanta, GA, he immigrated to Canada in 1975 where he obtained additional training in Pediatric Infectious Diseases before joining the faculty of the University of Manitoba in Winnipeg. He returned to Atlanta in 1982 to serve as Director of US Public Services STD Laboratory Program. In 1984, he returned to Canada as Head of the Department of Microbiology at the University of Saskatchewan. He then went to Edmonton as Director of the Provincial Laboratory of Public Health in 1990. In 2002, after a period in private practice in Florida, he returned to Saskatoon as Dean of the College of Medicine.
