His research is in the area of solid state physics, especially optical spectroscopy at extreme conditions in IR – THz regions and photoemission spectroscopy of strongly correlated materials. He has also designed two IR beamlines at SPring-8 and at UVSOR-II and two VUV photoemission beamlines at UVSOR-II. His recent interest is a pump-probe experiment of the combination of intense coherent THz radiation with photoemission spectroscopy.
